## RESOLUTION

# Urging Ohio Lawmakers to Follow a Consistent and Deliberative Process Before Approving Legislation

- WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly added last-minute amendments regarding the expansion of the EdChoice Voucher program before approving HB166, the State's biennium budget; and,
- WHEREAS, EdChoice Vouchers are now available to any and every K-12 student in Ohio, regardless of grade level and/or whether he or she ever attended a public school; and,
- WHEREAS, the aforementioned amendments allow students who receive EdChoice Vouchers to take different state assessments than what students in Ohio's public school districts are required to take; and,
- WHEREAS, alternate assessments for voucher students will make it more difficult to evaluate the effectiveness of an education received by EdChoice Voucher recipients when compared with counterparts in traditional public schools; and,
- WHEREAS, similar legislation related to voucher expansion (HB200) stalled in the House Education and Career Readiness Committee in 2017; and,
- WHEREAS, legislators are currently trying to unwind previous last-minute legislation attached to HB70, regarding Academic Distress Commissions; and,
- WHEREAS, the Board of Education believes that every piece of legislation introduced in either the Ohio House of Representatives or the Ohio Senate should follow a consistent and deliberative process, allowing ample opportunity for public review and comment; and,
- WHEREAS, the voucher expansion and academic distress commission amendments circumvented that thorough, deliberative process;
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Northmont City Schools Board of Education, Montgomery County, Ohio, urges the lawmakers in the State of Ohio to refrain from approving any new legislation or attaching any version thereof, which has already been introduced in any Ohio House or Senate committee to a different and/or larger piece of legislation, before the original legislation has been properly vetted and heard by both chambers of the Ohio General Assembly according to rules established by the Ohio Constitution.
